

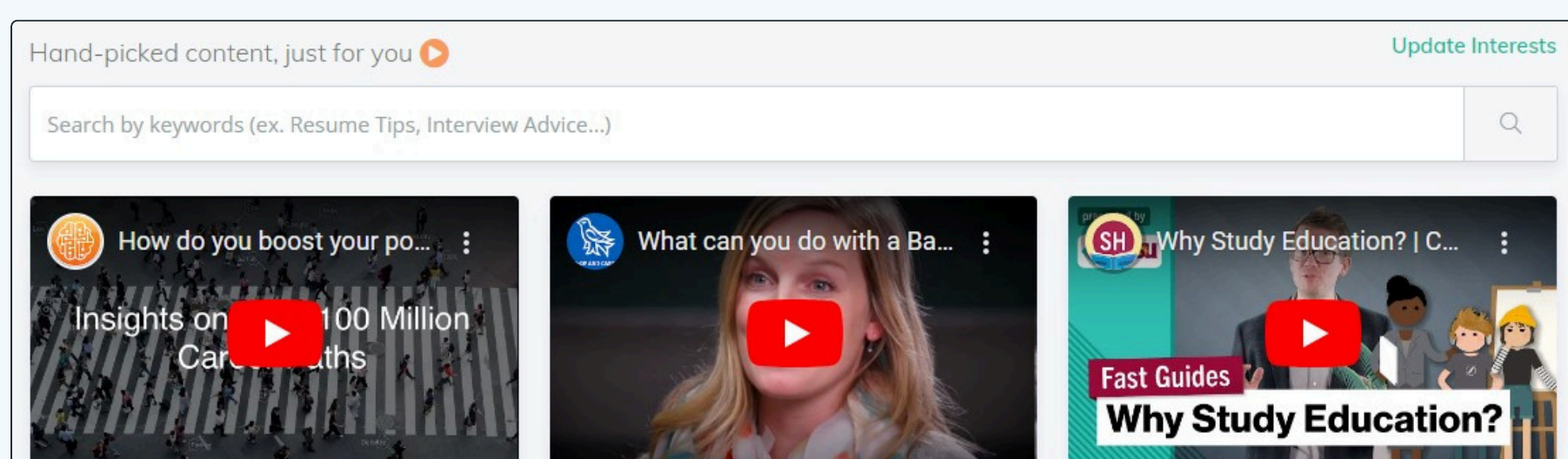
# Digital Career Counselor

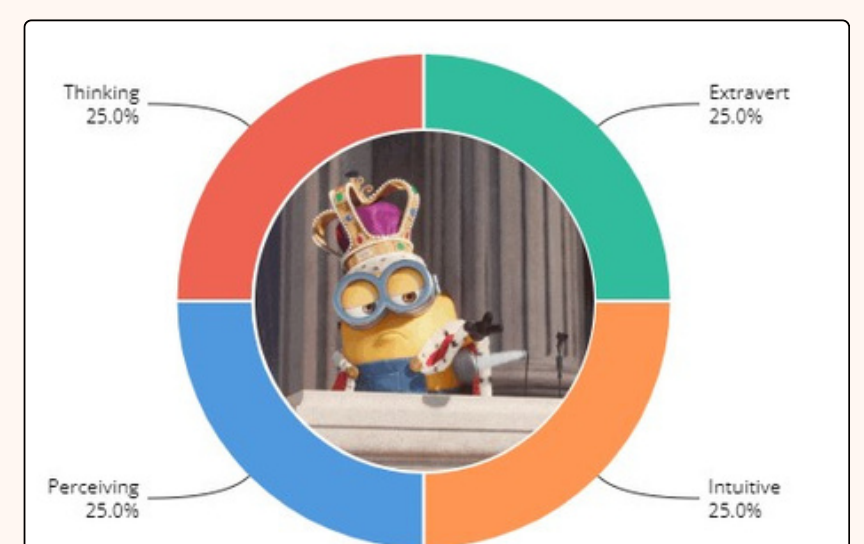


- 2 Encourage students to take the personality assessment to gain insight to how their personality aligns with certain majors and/or career options.

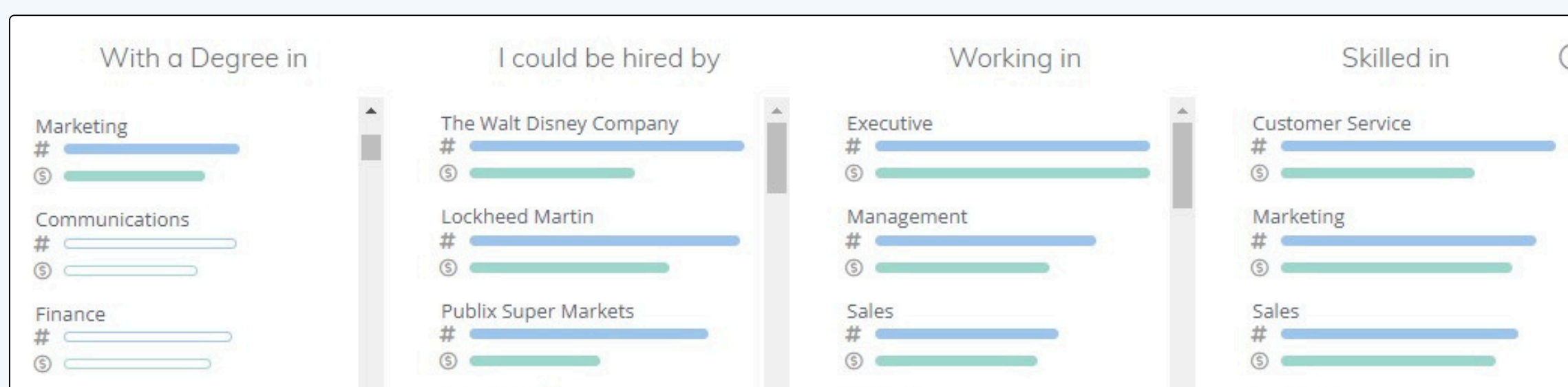
### Best Majors for ENTPs
