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### What is Digital Career Counselor?




- Top majors and career paths for their personality type



#### Home Page / Career Feeds Module




Career Feeds is a great way for students to explore different career areas, and start identifying career paths that interest them!

#### Personality Module

The Personality Module allows students to answer 20 binary questions and then learn their personality type, as well as relevant majors and job titles that may interest them.



After completing the 20 question assessment, students will see and overview of their personality type.

To learn more about their personality type, students can download their custom personality report.

As they scroll down the page, they will see a list of best majors for their personality type, as well as a list of best jobs.

For each major and job, they can click on the title to search our entire dataset of 135+ million people to learn more about career outcomes for that major/job.

#### Best Majors for ESFJs




## **Digital Career Counselor**Search 360 Module - Education

In the Search 360 module, **students can search our entire dataset of 135+ million people.** Students start by searching for either a job title or major. The first thing they will see is the Education Background tab, which provides information about people in that job/major and their education types and levels.

In the Search 360 module, students can search our entire dataset of 135+ million people. In the second tab, they will see information about employment.



In the Top Companies section, students can see the top companies for that job title or major, along with salary and skills info. Students can also click the blue link to see open jobs at that company.


#### Steppingblocks **Pro Tip**

In the Search 360 module, students can search our entire dataset of 135+ million people. In the last tab, students can view the top skills related to their desired job title or major, and start making a plan to develop those skills.


The relevance column and blue bars represent how significant these skills are to the searched terms in relation to the general population.


#### **Tuition Module**
